You will need a lease title or mortgage statement to show control of the property.

Consider using the name of the street of the facility for the name of your facility. The name of your facility can be separate from the name of the business or corp. For example: Alondra Residential

Step 5

Consider obtaining a fire inspection prior to submitting your license application. Contact your local fire dept for a pre-inspection for an Adult Residential Facility.

Step 6

After you submit your application you will be notified by Licensing. Once an LPA is assigned to your application you may receive corrections
